INFORMATION UPDATE & 2022 RACE SCHEDULE

Welcome Racers & Crew Members:

CSRA has finalized our plans for the 2022 Snowcross race series. We have (9) race weekends scheduled, (See attached schedule of events on page #2).

We are excited about the 2022 race season however everyone needs to understand that we are still being guided by Provincial and Local Health Unit protocols that may be different at each event. We all need to be prepared for ongoing changes that may limit what we can do and how we operate our events. The health and safety of all our racers, crew members and staff are the number one priority.

Notes:

- To access a event site each day, a CSRA issued neck lanyard with 2022 ID Hard Card must be showing with each individual in your vehicle at the gate entrance.
- Working crew members may be parents and adults 18+ only with a valid 2022 CSRA Crew membership.
- Each racer and crew member must bring a signed waiver with them each race weekend and hand it to the front gate admission attendant to access the event property.
- Neck Lanyards with 2022 ORANGE ID Hard Cards must be visible outside your jacket at all times. Anyone without a visible lanyard with ID and a Upper body TekVest will not be permitted in the staging or start line areas.
- Racers do not need to wear their ID Lanyard when they have their helmet on.
- There will not be any on site sign in, or registration, or class changes on site at the events. All racer registration will be done on line with RACEDAY from the CSRA website link.
- There will be no close gatherings as in previous years such as rider's meetings or group awards presentations. Morning riders meeting will be done by radio transmission at most events.
- There may not be any on site food service. Be prepared and bring food for the weekend.
- Face coverings (masks, gators, balaclavas that cover your mouth and nose may be required by everyone on site, please be prepared and have face coverings with you at all times.
Hand wash sanitation stations will be set up throughout the event site including entrances and Pit areas, it is recommended that you use them often throughout the day.

Friday afternoon Safety inspection for all classes at the first two events.

CSRA tech staff will be on site Friday from 12:00 noon to 5:00PM for advance pit parking and pre race safety inspection of your race sleds.

Note: Safety protocols will be in effect when you arrive at the race site on Friday.

Only CSRA Racers & Crew members with lanyards and 2022 hard card ID with completed waivers will be permitted on site.

Helmets and Upper body requirements:

Helmets may be any colour this year, ISR recommends Hi Vis colours.

Helmets need to be ECE 22.05 approved, or Snell 2015 or newer approved full coverage helmet.

Helmet cams or data acquisition devices are not permitted on helmets.

Racers competing with Novice 200cc sleds and all full size sleds and Snow Bikes are required to have a minimum of 144 sq. inches of International Blaze Orange on upper body Front and Back.

(Recommended but not required for 120 racers).

Crew Safety Vests Requirements:

Racer crew members are required to wear Upper Body Safety Vests while they are in the Hot Pit Warm up area Staging Lanes and Starting Line areas. Crew Vests must be Snowcross type safety vests such as Tekvest they can be any style or color.

(Motocross Vests do not meet ISR standards and can not be used).

CSRA will not be renting vests or helmets this year due to C19 protocol, we have a limited quantity of used vests available for sale.

Entry Fee Deadlines, Forms & Requirements:

This year all racers are required to register on line with the RACEDAY link on the CSRA website by Monday prior to each race event. The system allows racers to build a racer profile to promote your team and sponsors. See the attached RACEDAY instructions and info. Your race entry is required by the Monday prior to each race weekend. (no exceptions). You can not register on site at the events and there is no Friday night sign in at the race site or hotels.

Safety Inspection Form:

All racers including 120s are required to have their race sleds safety inspected before they race. When your sled is inspected by CSRA officials a Safety Inspection band will be attached to your handle bars, this band must be visible at all times, otherwise your sled will need to be re-inspected before you enter the start line area.

Please see the attached safety Inspection Form check list and ensure your sled and rider safety equipment are ready for inspection when you arrive at your first race.

NEW INFO FOR SNOW BIKE & UTV RACERS

Snow Bike Racing Classes: (Pro/Am 450cc and Ripper 110cc for Kids 6-13 yrs.)

CSRA will include a 450cc Snow Bike Racing classes at each CSRA National event.

We have also introduced a Ripper 110cc class at all Regional events.

Snow Bikes must be 0-450cc, and must be equipped with a silencer, AMA engine mod rules apply, race fuel must be commercially available in Canada, traction products are not allowed. Age requirements are (14+) for the 450cc class and (6–13) years for age for the 110cc Ripper class. The 110cc class may be divided into two age groups if needed based on the total entries.

All Snow Bike participants are required to purchase a CSRA annual membership so we can allocate a racer number, all Crew members must also purchase a CSRA Crew Membership to access the events.

2022 RACE SEASON TRACK & PIT RULES & PENALTIES

- **Drivers Meetings / Racer & Crew Member Information:**

Racers and Crew members are required to be aware of current information for each race weekend.

Be sure to listen to your Driver & Crew information each race morning.

(see the on site radio station broadcast information on the Racer Information Board by Staging Lanes).

Yellow Flag: No passing or any air time when a Yellow flag is being waved. The Yellow flag zone is the area from where the Yellow flag is flying to the downed rider or sled.

If a racer makes up time on the racer ahead in the Yellow Zone the racer will be penalized (1) position.

If a racer passes another racer or gets air over a jump in a yellow zone the racer will be assessed a (1) lap penalty or disqualification at the race director's discretion.

- **Speeding in Pits:** Be aware **ZERO TOLERANCE** The maximum (off track) speed limit at CSRA events is 10KMH. or idling. Racers or crew members that exceed this limit may be fined and or be required to leave the property.

- **Helmets and Tether Cords:** Must be used by all riders under (18) years of age any time a Powersports vehicle is moving on site at our events. Adults may move Powersports vehicles without a helmet at speeds under 10km. **Tether Cords** must be functional and must be hooked to the vehicle operator at any time that the sled is being moved.

Note: A minimum fine of \$100 will be allocated for each infraction.

- **Off Track while racing:** If a racer leaves the designated race track area while racing, the racer must stop completely and look for on coming racers before entering back onto the track. Otherwise a (1) position or (1) lap or DQ penalty will be assessed at the discretion of the race director.
- **Start Line:** If a racer crosses the designated start line, or jumps the Green start light, the racer / racers will be moved to a back row start position, behind a front row sled, by the start line official.
- **Transponders:** Must be located in the correct position on the race sled. The Racer may not be scored without a functional transponder in the correct mounting position. (Confirm mounting position with Tech).
- **Fuel:** It is the racers responsibility to ensure that the correct legal fuel is used and proper limiters are in place if required for any given class as per CSRA rules.
- **Verbal or Physical abuse:** Any racer or Crew member that threatens or verbally or physically abuses a CSRA official or another racer or crew member will be disqualified for the day, weekend, or race series at the discretion of the race director.
- **Drivers Meetings:** Are always important as new information is announced for each race day. This year to do distancing protocol, Riders meeting will be done by radio transmission in your vehicle or Trailer.

Racers & Crew members: Racers are responsible for their Crew members and must ensure that crew members are aware of current CSRA Covid Protocol, as well as, track and pit area rules.

BRING YOUR RIDER SAFETY EQUIPMENT TO INSPECTION WITH YOUR SLED

- _____ Snell 2015 or ECE 22.05 approved helmet with safety approval showing on the helmet.
- _____ Tekvest chest protector. (Motocross chest protectors are not legal for Snowmobile racing).
- _____ 144 sq. Inches of International Blaze orange on vest, or Race Jacket. Front and Rear.
- _____ Shin Pads

FIRE SAFETY NOTE:

- Every Race Trailer must have a Fire Extinguisher mounted near a entrance door.
- Propane Tanks must be strapped or chained to your trailer so they cannot fall over.

SPONSOR DECALS REQUIRED ON YOUR SLED TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AWARDS

Decals are provided with your membership kit and will also be available at Tech Inspection.

Note: CSRA Series Sponsor decals must be visible trackside while you are racing. If decals are not visible racers will not be eligible for CSRA prize money or race winnings.

SLED SAFETY

- _____ Rear Snow flaps on full size race sleds must touch the snow surface when the racer sits on the sled.
Material must be a rigid plastic material. See new 2022 ISR Snow Flap rules.
- _____ Head light and Tail light must be taped with clear tape. Tail light must be operational.
- _____ Racer numbers on race sled must be Black 6"-7" high on sides & 3" high on front.
- _____ 1" diameter ski hoops minimum. Ski hoops must attach under the front of Ski. Skis tight.
- _____ Handle bars and steering components tight.
- _____ Throttle & Brake operation OK.
- _____ Tether cord (5'Ft. max) kills engine. Max 12 lbs. release pressure tested with a fish scale.
- _____ Thumb kill switch on right side handle bar and working.
- _____ Stud length & type correct (Maximum 108 single point). Carbides – No sharpening.
- _____ No studs on 120cc, Novice 200, Junior Novice, Transition classes).
- _____ Clutch guard must be OEM undamaged and secure.
- _____ **NO Orange** on snowmobile. (Hyfax or dashboard excluded).
