IMPORTANT RACER INFORMATION – PLEASE BE PREPARED

- Please be prepared on arrival at the front gates with your 2022 Racer & Crew ID Lanyards and Hard Cards, as well as, signed Waivers for each person in your vehicle. Blank Waivers can be found in Race Day under “Library”.
- Front entrance gates open at 9:00AM. Friday and 6:00AM Saturday and Sunday.
- Front entrance gates will be closed at 8:00PM each night.
- Everyone is required to wear 2022 Racer or Crew ID Lanyards.
- Face coverings need to worn properly in group areas such as the Starting line and Staging areas, or any other area when distancing isn't possible.
- Transponders will be available for rent on site at each event at the Scoring RV.
- There are no onsite helmet rentals or Tekvest rentals.
- Due to Provincial restrictions, there is no onsite Food or Beverage services.
